

## Catch up funding - 2021/21 Captain Cook Primary School

Funding - £31,040

### Autumn Term Summary

All children have been assessed on their return in September as to whether they are on track, slightly below or below ARE in Reading, Writing and Maths. This data has been analysed against their last data entry (Feb 2019) and their last statutory data point to determine the progress required.

We have taken the decision to invest our catch up funding in phonics training and resources, pastoral support, additional educational psychologist time and early booster lessons for our Year 6 pupils during the Autumn term. We will continue to evaluate the most effective way to support our pupils and Spring and Summer plans may change accordingly.

The app has been very successful in supporting parents at home. 89% of our Year 2 children passed the phonics check in December 2020. Following Ed Pysch involvement 2 children are now in the process of applying for an EHCP. We have also been able to offer more tailored support to parents. In Reception we have employed an extra member of staff to support children who have missed out on early reading and maths skills. Booster classes for targeted Year 6 children have been delivered in the Autumn term. Our Pastoral Lead has worked with 12 children. She has also introduced Well Being Wednesdays.
