Uniform and Bookbags

A reminder to all parents that our school uniform consists of:

 White shirt or polo shirt; grey trousers or skirt; plain red jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt; black shoes

PE kit (to be worn on PE days):

• Plain black track suit bottoms or leggings (shorts can be worn underneath); plain red tee shirt; trainers; school red jumper or a plain red sweatshirt or fleece over the top

All items of uniform/PE kit should be plain with no branding or logos visible (apart from the school logo.)

Please also ensure that the children come to school each day with a school book bag. Due to issues with space, we are unable to accommodate other bags/backpacks in school.

I'm sure that you appreciate how important maintaining high standards of uniform (including book bags and PE kit) are to ensuring high standards throughout school, and I am very grateful for your continued support. If any parents are struggling in relation to uniform and/or book bags, please contact the school office for assistance.



Key Stage 2 Pick Up

In order to assist staff with ensuring that the children are delivered safely to adults collecting them at the end of the day, we are trialling the use of class collection zones in Upper School playground at the end of the day. Please can adults collecting children assemble at the labelled flagpole of their child's class. The class teacher will then walk the children out to that area and hand over to the waiting adults.

Children in Year 5 or 6 will only be permitted to walk home themselves if we have received written permission for them to do this. Please complete the form sent home with your child today and return to school as soon as possible if you wish your child to do this.

I would also like to remind you that children should only be collected by adults or those over 16 (this includes siblings.)
