Return to school

Our new school term commences for children on Tuesday 9th January, 2024. As you will know, for some time we have been opening doors 15 minutes before registration closes. We have noticed the detrimental effect of some children arriving later than their peers (as doors are closing). This means that these children are often missing out on valuable learning time – up to one hour 15 minutes per week. Therefore, from January, we would like all children to arrive at school as the doors open (Lower School 8.40am, Upper School 8.45 am.) To help with this transition period, doors will continue to remain open for 15 minutes until February half term. We would very much appreciate your support, as class teachers have revised timetables in accordance with this. We will be evaluating the effect of this change at half term.

Uniform

Finally, a plea to everyone to ensure that our school uniform rules are adhered to and that all items of clothing coming into school are clearly labelled with your child's name. This greatly assists with returning lost items of clothing to their rightful owner.
