## **Parking**

As some of you may be aware, the Daily Mail wrote an article regarding dangerous parking around schools. Our school was named in this article. Whilst we do accept that parking is an issue here, the majority of schools face similar problems.

In an effort to alleviate the problems parents face, we are currently exploring the possibility of setting up walking buses. These would operate from the Southern Cross and/or the Rudds Arms car parks, and would involve parents dropping their child off at 8.25am where school staff (and if possible volunteers) would escort them safely to school. Children could be escorted back to the car parks at the end of the school day, where they could be collected at around 3.30pm.
