NURSERY DROP-OFFS/PICK UPS

In order to keep all of our children in school as safe as possible, we are making changes to the entry point for parents and carers who are dropping off children to, and collecting from, our nursery. Therefore, from Monday 23rd June, we are asking parents/carers and Nursery children to use the MAIN PEDESTRIAN ENTRANCE GATE to school, situated near the main school reception. This will ensure that we can closely monitor who is coming on the school site.

As these new arrangements will involve walking down the hill to Nursery and cars/delivery vans can be entering or leaving the car park at any time, please can adults ensure that they hold their child's hand at all times. We would also be grateful if you could pass this message along to all adults who drop-off or collect your child in order to avoid confusion.

NURSERY CLOSURES: Friday 18th July (pm) and Tuesday 2nd September 2025 (all day)

We are hoping to make substantial refurbishments to our EYFS environment over the summer break. We are very excited about this and are hoping the changes will be of great benefit to the youngest members of our school community. In order to facilitate this, **Nursery will be closing at 12.30 on the last day of term (Friday 18th July) and will not re-open until Wednesday 3rd September.** For our current N2s who are moving to Reception in September, **Reception will be open for children alongside the rest of the school on Tuesday 2nd September.** Parents of new starters who are affected by this closure will be contacted separately to arrange a new starting date.

We apologise for any inconvenience this causes, however we only close Nursery when we really have to. If you have any queries or concerns, please get in touch with the school office. We are trying to give everyone as much notice as possible to enable you to make other arrangements, and hope that the changes will significantly improve our environment which will benefit everyone.
